1 & 2 Samuel

The Columbus area Celebrate Recovery programs have an opportunity to provide an 8-week series called "Hurts, Habits, and Hang-ups: A Series on the Beatitudes." Several churches plan to kick off the series August 11 including Ogilville Christian Church by offering small group lessons during the 10:30 am service. The last Sunday class will be on September 29 with a community picnic/CR event to celebrate the culmination of the class. There will be more announcements concerning the picnic to follow.

The 8-session class uses the Beatitudes of Jesus as a foundation. Pastor Rick Warren and Pastor John Baker from Saddleback Church developed eight choices that promise happiness and a life transformation. John Baker wrote the book "Life's Healing Choices" based on a way to get freedom from your hurts, habit's and hang-ups. It addresses the fact that we will all experience problems in life. We will all

face the dilemma of determining where we go from life's issues. Lessons for the class will be taken from John Baker's book and the small group study that accompanies. The sessions for the Sunday morning study are as follows:
